## DAY 1: Saturday 15 September DEPART MELBOURNE

Depart Melbourne this evening on your Emirates flight to Dubai. On arrival, transfer to your connecting Emirates flight to Amman.

## DAY 2: Sunday 16 September AMMAN / PETRA

Arrive into Amman this morning. We will be met & assisted with our transfer to Petra for dinner and overnight.

### DAY 3: Monday 17 September

Enjoy a spectacular tour exploring the rose-red city of Petra. Enjoy a short horse ride, and then travel on foot through the awesome 'SIQ' valley. Visit the Treasury, and explore hundreds of buildings, tombs, temples, and a 3,000-seat theatre: the first-century AD. Return to your hotel for some rest. A private dinner by candlelight in Little Petra has been arranged for this evening.

Allenby Bridge for crossing to Israel. Drive via the fertile Jordan Valley and visit Beit Shean, also called "Scythopolis" - the biggest archeological park in Israel with beautiful excavations from Roman and Byzantine periods. On to your hotel in Tiberias for dinner and overnight Overnight: Tiberias

### DAY 6: Thursday 20 September SEA OF GALILEE

Experience an early morning sail across the Sea of Galilee. The ride will end at Ginosar, where we shall visit the ancient boat from the time of Jesus that was found nearby. Visit Tabgha, where the miracle of the Multiplication took place. Continue onto Capernaum, the centre of Jesus' ministries. Ascend to the top of the Mt. of Beatitudes, where you can relive the Sermon on the Mount. Visit the Baptismal site in the Jordan River at Yardenit. Return to your hotel for dinner. Overnight: Tiberias

# DAY 7: Friday 21 September GOLAN HEIGHTS

Start the day with a visit to Tel Dan - a National Park combining a lush nature reserve with a biblical archaeological experience. This was the capital of the ancient Northern Kingdom, where you can see a High Place, ancient city gates, and other finds. Continue on for a walk through Caesarea-Phillippi at Banias Falls. Ascend the Golan Heights and from Mt. Bental, peer deep into Syria and the ghost





town of Kuneitra. Enjoy an optional tour of a local winery or visit a brewery making beer from the fresh waters of the Jordan River. Overnight: Tiberias

#### DAY 8: Saturday 22 September NAZARETH, MEGIDDO, MT CARMEL, CAESAREA, TEL AVIV

Drive to Nazareth for a visit to the Church of the Annunciation and Mary's Well. Continue to the ancient city of Meggido at the crossroads of an important ancient highway identified as the site of Armageddon. See the ancient city that was inhabited continuously for more than five millennia. Drive to Haifa and view the Baha'i Gardens from the top of Mt Carmel. See the Carmelite Monastery at the Muchrakah, where Elijah smote the false prophets. Continue to the ancient city of Caesarea Maritima to see the harbour city built by Herod the Great. Proceed to Tel Aviv for dinner & overnight. Overnight: Tel Aviv

# DAY 9: Sunday 23 September JAFFA, BEERSHEBA, DEAD SEA

Start your day with a short visit to the ancient port city of Old Jaffa and hear tales of Simon the Tanner and Jonah and the Whale. Drive south to Beersheba and enjoy a special day commemorating the achievements of the Australian soldiers in World War One. Follow the ANZAC trail and the main battlefield sites in the area and see the magnificent new Park of the Australian Soldier. Continue onto the Dead Sea for dinner and overnight.

# DAY 10: Monday 24 September MASADA, EIN GEDI, DEAD SEA

Ascend the mighty fortress of Masada via cable car. Explore the remains of King Herod's luxurious palace and hear about the zealots who defied the Roman Empire from this location. Walk to the falls at Ein Gedi Oasis. Spend the remainder of the afternoon at leisure floating in the salty waters of the Dead Sea.

## DAY 11: Tuesday 25 September (Yom Kippur Eve) QUMRAN, JERUSALEM

Travel northwards along the Dead Sea to the caves of Qumran where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. Ascend the mountains to the holy city of Jerusalem. Start your visit with a magnificent view of the city from the Mount of Olives. See the Church of all Nations at the Garden of Gethsemane. 2pm check into your Jerusalem hotel before roads close for the Yom Kippur holy day. Spend remainder of afternoon observing preparations for the holiest day of the Jewish calendar. Dinner and overnight is at your hotel.

### DAY 12: Wednesday 26 September (Yom Kippur)

Today is at leisure exploring the Old City on your own. All roads are closed to vehicular traffic and it is a unique time to experience the city by foot. Return for late lunch and then dinner at your hotel. Overnight: Jerusalem

## DAY 13: Thursday 27 September JERUSALEM - OLD CITY

Onto Mt. Zion to the Room of the Last Supper located in the Upper Room, above King David's Tomb. Enter the Old City via Lion's Gate. Visit the Pools of Bethesda and St. Anne's Church. Pass through Ecce

Homo Arch to the Via Dolorosa and onto the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Proceed to the Jewish Quarter for a tour of the secret Western Wall Tunnels. Visit the City of David. Walk through Warren's Shaft and Hezekiah's Tunnel to the Pool of Siloam. Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

## DAY 14: Friday 28 September JERUSALEM - NEW CITY, BETHLEHEM

This morning experience a moving visit to the Yad Vashem Holocaust Memorial. Onto the Shrine of the Book to see the original Dead Sea Scrolls and see the model of Herodian Jerusalem at the Israel Museum. Enjoy an afternoon visit to Bethlehem to see the Shepherds' Fields, Manger Square and the Church of the Nativity. Enjoy a festive farewell dinner at the village of Abu Gosh before returning to your hotel in Jerusalem.

### DAY 16: Sunday 30 September PYRAMIDS

In the afternoon return for a fascinating tour of the Great Pyramids at Giza, the 7th wonder of the world. See the magnificent Sphinx from close up. Option to venture inside a pyramid and have the opportunity to view the ancient burial tomb of the Pharaohs (cost not included). Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

## DAY 17: Monday 1 October OLD CAIRO

Enjoy a guided tour of the world famous Egyptian Museum, which houses the treasures of the "Boy King" – Tutankhamun, the mummy





of Ramses II as well as some of the most famous ancient art pieces in the world. Spend the rest of the day exploring the old Coptic Quarter of Cairo. Visit the beautiful Hanging Church and see the 11th Century Ben Ezra Synagogue. Dinner and overnight is at your hotel.

### DAY 18: Tuesday 2 October

Early morning transfer to Cairo Airport for your domestic flight to Aswan. Start your tour with a visit to the High Dam, an engineering miracle built in 1960 protecting Egypt from annual floods from the Nile. Proceed to visit the unfinished Obelisk which shows the techniques used by the ancient Egyptians to cut obelisks. Then onto the majestic Philae Temple, which was built in honour of the goddess Isis, the chief deity of the island. Embark your Nile cruise ship for lunch, and enjoy a felucca ride around the Agha Khan Mausoleum in the afternoon.

# DAY 19: Wednesday 3 October KOM OMBO

Enjoy a free morning OR board your Egypt Air morning flight to Abu Simbel. Visit the temples of Nefertari and Ramses - the masterpieces of ancient Egypt reflecting the glory and grandeur of the new Kingdom. Fly back to Aswan for lunch. In the afternoon sail to Kom

Umbo and visit the temple of Kom Umbo which stands on high ground overlooking the River Nile. Sail onto Edfu.


